



## STOCKMAN'S CHALLENGE

Sunday 27 January 2019

### OPEN – Men and Ladies – Limit to 10 competitors

#### Events

##### 1. Jumping – 9:30am – Ring 2

- Set show jumping course. Course will not exceed 80cm.
- Points:
  - i. Starting points 50 for riding bareback
  - ii. Starting points 20 for riding in saddle
  - iii. Penalties will be deducted from starting points, i.e. 4 points will be deduct for a rail or refusal.
  - iv. Elimination = Minus 50

##### 2. Shoe or trim – 11:00am at back of grandstand

- Competitors can choose to shoe (front and hind) or trim (front and hind).
- Points:
  - i. Maximum 50 points for shoeing.
  - ii. Maximum 20 points for trimming.
- Forfeit option available for this section.

##### 3. Pack horse – 1:00pm front of bar

- Competitors required to pack the saddle bags, saddle horse and lead horse around simple course. Max 10 minutes per round.
- Unpacking not judged and not included in time.

##### 4. Wet work – 2:30pm Rodeo arena

- This event requires competitors to cut out a beast and work the cow

##### 5. Whip crack – 3:30pm Rodeo arena

- Set whip crack course with 1 minute freestyle component.

##### 6. Obstacle course – 5:00pm Rodeo arena

- Competitors complete obstacle course
  - i. Maximum 50 points for riding bareback.
  - ii. Maximum 30 points for riding in saddle.

Competitor with most points at end of challenge wins.

**JUNIORS – 13 years and under– Limit to 5 competitors**

### **Events**

**1. Jumping – 9:00am – Ring 2**

- Set show jumping course. Course will not exceed 60cm.
- Points:
  - i. Starting points = 50.
  - ii. Penalties will be deducted from starting points, i.e. 4 points will be deduct for a rail or refusal.
  - iii. Elimination = Minus 50

**2. Pack horse – 12:00pm front of bar**

- Competitors required to saddle own horse and lead a packed horse around simple course. Max 6 minutes per round.

**3. Wet work – 2:30pm Rodeo arena**

- This event requires competitors to cut out a beast and move cow around a course.

**4. Whip crack – 3:30pm Rodeo arena**

- Set whip crack course with 1 minute freestyle component.

**5. Obstacle course – 5:00pm Rodeo arena**

- Competitors complete obstacle course with a saddle on.

Competitor with most points at end of challenge wins.
